## Play School Closing

## Tuition Payments

Beginning in February, we will no longer be accepting tuition payments in cash. We will gladly accept payments by check, credit card (at Stoney and Saxony locations, for a small convenience charge), or money order by Wednesday of each week.

## Illness & Medication Policy

We would like to remind all of our Play School families of our illness and medication policies.

### Illness Policy:

- Children will be sent home if they are vomiting, have a fever of 101+, three or more bouts of diarrhea (two within one hour), or have any unexplained rash. Children who exhibit a failure to participate will also be sent home and may return when fully able to participate in normal activities.
- A child must be fever or symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school. The child may return to school the following day only if they have been seen by a doctor and have a note indicating that they are not contagious.
- Unidentified rashes must be checked by a physician and the child may return with a note stating that they are not contagious.

### Medication Policy:

- If you are using any type of OTC (over the counter) medication for your child you must provide the medication, submit a doctor's order (with each illness) stating the illness, dosage, frequency, and time frame of giving said medication.
- Prescription drugs will be given to the child labeled on the package at the stated dosage and frequency.
